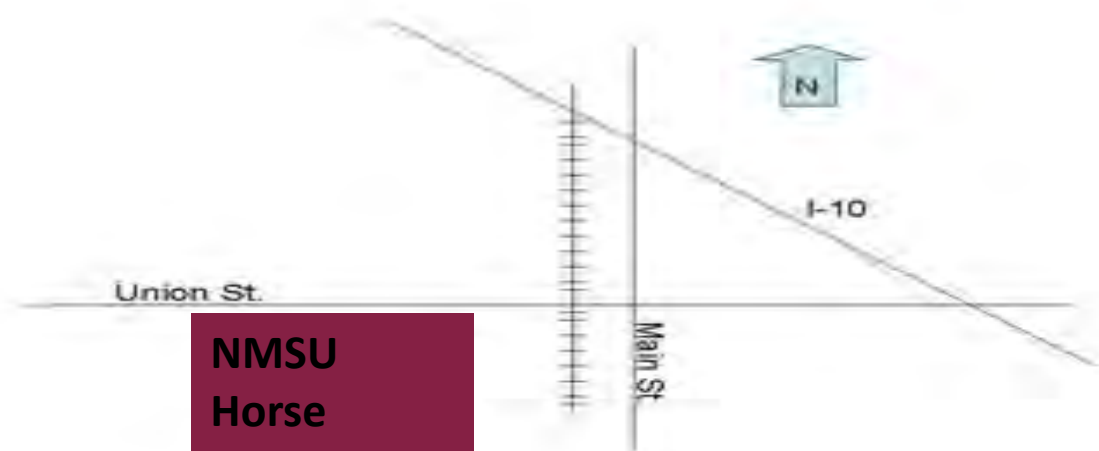

Sale will be conducted by Integrity Livestock Sales LLC. All information on bidding, and buyer registration can be found at [https:// www.integritylivestocksales.com](https://www.integritylivestocksales.com)

- Terms of sale are cash. **Payments must be made in full to NMSU before horse can be picked up** Buyers must make arrangements to pay for their purchases by Tuesday May 3. 1. Cash, Checks, Master Card, Visa, and Discover Cards will be accepted Make all checks payable to NMSU Horse Farm
 - All registration papers will be mailed complete with signed transfer certificates and breeding certificates (when applicable) directly to the buyer (NMSU will no longer pay transfer fees, due to changes in processing at AQHA). All Registrations and transfers will be mailed July 15, 2022 to the buyer listed Please give the clerk the correct name and address of the person to whom the animal is to be transferred. Buyers will be provided with Coggins test, and health certificate for each horse going out of State at no charge. **Any further expenses and arrangements associated with exportation of horses to other countries will be the buyer's responsibility.**
 - The highest bidder is the buyer.
 - All horses will be sold to the highest bidder all horses will have a minimum starting bid.
 - The buyer will assume **all risks and expense** of the animal after the close of the bid by the auctioneer. Animals purchased at this sale will be cared for by the seller, but at the buyer's risk until the animal can be picked up. All horses need to be picked up by May 8, 2022 Please notify us as to when you are going to pick up your horse.

Out of **LOVE EM N LENA**, an AQHA point earner. She earned \$112,552.77 in the NRCHA. She is the dam of 24 foals, 12 of whom are earners in NRHA, NRCHA, SHOT, and NCHA.
